On Saturday 9th July over 800 women joined Peace Hospice Care for its 10th and final Starlight Walk; raising over £70,000. Over the years, the Hospice's Starlight Walk has become a well-known annual event. For the 10th and final Walk, celebrity supporter, Wendi Peters, best known as Cilla Battersby-Brown on Coronation Street, joined the walkers, with live entertainment by the

local band McVicar. The Saraswati Academy of Indian Dance with The Village School of Dance created an energetic and lively warm up with a brilliant Zumba routine. Both the 6 mile and 13 mile routes started at the Watford Colosseum at 9pm. Wendi Peters lead the way down Watford High Street, the walk then continued through Bushey, Croxley Green and Cassiobury Park. There was a very moving candle display to remember loved ones, before finishing back at the Watford Colosseum. Throughout the routes, Starlight Walkers were kindly treated to locally donated snacks. A Note from the Directors BEMC (Byewaters Estate Management Company)

The directors of BEMC recently met to discuss the general appearance of the estate. Our attention has been drawn to the trees and large bushes which have grown and matured across the estate. As autumn approaches we plan to commence a program of work to cut back these trees and bushes to open up the views and light on the maintained areas of estate. We also urge owners of individual homes to consider trimming back their trees and large bushes to both improve the look of their gardens – and ensure that the roots of these plants and trees do not damage the foundations of their properties. As I'm sure you will have noticed, most of the streetlights on the estate have been modified to use white LEDs instead of orange sodium bulbs. We understand that this is intended to reduce power consumption and match Hertfordshire Highways requirements. One of the curious aspects of the estate is that so far, we are in the dark regarding which organisation took the decision to do this. We have asked Barratt to enlighten us about this and we hope to tell you more in the next newsletter. A council in the West Midlands is launching a scheme for responsible dog owners/the public to tip off the council/wardens when they see other dog owners allowing their dogs to foul and not pick up after them. The fine of around £75 will then be handed to the person who reported the irresponsible owner. Seems like a good idea, on the spot fines and less children able to get Toxocariasis from dog faeces. Hopefully this will be taken up by other Councils. Please, please pick up don't let your pet be the cause of a child losing their eye sight. Biodegradable bags are **FREE** from the Parish Council Offices and some libraries. Always think of others and use bags to pick up after your pet and then BIN it!!

Making it easier for Hertfordshire's residents to find a reputable trader, marks the launch of a brand-new partnership between Hertfordshire County Council and Which? Trusted Traders. The scheme provides a list of local traders that can be used knowing they've been checked and assessed before being endorsed. To join, a business must apply for an assessment, which comprises a set of tailored background checks, including criminal records, creditworthiness, any county court judgments and maintenance of insurance. References are required from previous customers and applicants must agree to abide by the scheme's code of conduct. Only if all requirements are met, will a business be able to join as an endorsed trader. The business will then be monitored and reassessed every year. We cannot promise that an endorsed trader's work will be perfect every time, but you can expect any problems to be dealt with fairly by the business. Plus, any business who fails to comply with the code of conduct can be suspended or removed. If something does go wrong, consumers also have the reassurance of an independent Alternative Dispute Resolution service. Endorsed traders can use the new Hertfordshire Trading Standard approved and Which? **Trusted trader** endorsement logo, and consumers can find a profile of the traders at: www.whichtrustedtraders.co.uk or contact Derrick Sweeney, Watch Liaison Officer derrick.sweeney@herts.pnn.police.uk Tel: 01707 355841

General Contact Advice: Telephone 999 in an emergency where there is a danger to life or a crime is in progress. Telephone 101 for non-emergencies where police attendance is required, to report a crime or to report any other incidents. Calls to 101 have a fixed cost of 15p per call.



Don't be the cause of an accident – 20mph or less !!

Do not be the cause of an accident, drive slowly around the estate and park sensibly so that visibility is not obscured for either pedestrians or other vehicles. Please, please can you keep your speeds down - **20mph or less** is best. Please think of others and try not to park on pavements or on blind spots. (Parking large vehicles on or close to corners is not advisable.) If your vehicle damages a pavement you will have to be charged for the repair. Please always think of others when driving and parking around Byewaters.
